

**NOTICE OF SELECTION FOR THE AWARD OF 4 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THOSE WHO INTEND TO ENROLL IN MESCI (MASTER IN DEVELOPMENT ECONOMICS AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION) IN THE A.Y. 2023-2024 CONSISTENT IN THE EXEMPTION FROM THE SECOND INSTALLMENT OF THE MASTER**

The Commission, having read the Call n.37/2023 published on the Department website on 09 June 2023, pursuant to current legislation, notes that the admission requirements are as follows:

1. At least B2 level knowledge of the English language (refer to the CEFR, at the link: [http://economia.uniroma2.it/public/def/files/Varie/Quadro\\_Comune\\_Europeo\\_delle\\_Lingue.pdf](http://economia.uniroma2.it/public/def/files/Varie/Quadro_Comune_Europeo_delle_Lingue.pdf)).
2. Achievement of a master's degree (or of the old system) according to the Italian system or, alternatively, a degree awarded abroad, at the end of a study course of at least four academic years.

To participate in the selection, the interested parties, in possession of the above requisites, have presented the formal application, necessarily using the appropriate forms attached to the announcement, which, under penalty of exclusion:

- contained all the personal data requested.
- were signed by the applicant, either with an electronic signature or with a scanned manual signature.
- they were accompanied by a declaration of the exams taken within the Courses of each of the Degrees obtained, necessarily with an indication of each relative mark.
- included the information on the processing of personal data, dated and signed (Annex 2).
- included a motivational letter to be attached to the application.
- were accompanied by a valid identification document.

Furthermore, the Commission, having read the announcement, notes that the ranking will be formulated based on the academic background of each candidate and the motivation as well as the interest in the issues of development economics and international cooperation verified during the individual interview.

In case of ex aequo, the younger candidate will be preferred.

The Commission proceeds with the evaluation of the applications received.

Finally, the Commission, having read the legislation in force concerning the award of scholarships, declares, after having heard each member in this regard, the inexistence of kinship or affinity relationships, up to the fourth degree included, as well as other situations of incompatibility provided for by articles 51 and 52 of the Code of Civil Procedure, both between the members of the Commission and between them and the candidates mentioned above.

The commission decides to assign the following score on the basis of the criteria mentioned in the official call:

- academic path points: maximum 10
- points for the CV: maximum 10
- professional experience points: maximum 10
- oral interview points: maximum 20
- total: maximum 50 points

At 14:00 individual interviews with each of the candidates begin on the MS Teams platform. Each candidate is given 10 minutes and interviews continue until 3.30pm.

The Commission proceeds with the examination of the applications presented by the candidates. After studying the questions and also taking into account the oral interview, the commission assigns the relative scores. The evaluation is based on the documentation sent by the candidates and on the performance during the individual interview.


